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Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of December 15, 2018.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Family of the Starting Person" the ancestors of John Stengel are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose ancestors are listed in the later chapters.


The chapter titled "Families of his Ancestors" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the ancestors of John Stengel. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 116 individuals, of whom 60 are male and 56 are female. Of the 61 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 52.51 years. Of these, 30 males averaged 51.6 years, and 31 females averaged 53.39 years. The longest living male was John Michael Link (1893–1979), who died aged 86. The longest living female was Anna Leora Stengel (1878–1974), who died aged 95.




Figure 1: AMSAT Cert




Figure 8: Corvette Museum




Figure 14: Farm Map




Figure 19: Ham License




Figure 20: Hikes Point Optimist




Figure 43: John P Stengel Boy Scouts




Figure 47: Optimist Intl




Figure 54: Renee 011




Figure 82: Stengel and Hydes Families




Figure 91: Dud and Jack B




Figure 106: Jack B Stengel Army Pic




Figure 109: Jack B Stengel Basic Training




Figure 115: Jack B Stengel OffOfDay Roster




Figure 116: Jack B Stengel Platoon Roster




Figure 117: Jack B Stengel Pres-1st Lt




Figure 118: Jack B Stengel Purple Heart




Figure 128: Jack Louise Marriage Cert




Figure 129: Jack Louise Marriage Lic




Figure 146: iPad Photo




Figure 150: Louise McCarthy HS Diploma


Figure 153: Mary Louise McCarthy Anna Stengel 1947






Figure 171: A & B Stengel A Large Obit




Figure 172: A & B Stengel A Large Obit




Figure 185: B&A Stengel 50th Anniv 1958




Figure 215: BenMaryLennWinGeoAnna 1065




Figure 260: Woodlow (Anna) Richard Birth Rec




Figure 266: U.S., World War I Draft Registration Cards, 1917-1918




Figure 269: U.S. City Directories, 1821-1899




Figure 271: Cornelious-Mary Marriage Lic




Figure 282: Mary T Link Holy Card




Figure 283: 1910 United States Federal Census






Figure 291: B Stengel Service Record Civil War




Figure 297: Bernard Stengel- Mary Lomas Marriage Lic




Figure 298: Bernard Stengel Naturalization




Figure 299: bernard Stengel Naturalization 1of2




Figure 307: Original Manifest




Figure 311: E Stengel 1880 Census




Figure 312: Elizabeth Burns 1860 census image




Figure 323: U.S. City Directories, 1821-1899




Figure 324: U.S. Naturalization Record Indexes, 1791-1992 (Indexed in World Archives Project)


Figure 325: 1860 United States Federal Census


Figure 339: U.S. City Directories, 1822-1995




Figure 346: 1880 United States Federal Census




Figure 347: 1930 United States Federal Census




Figure 348: U.S. City Directories, 1822-1995




Figure 350: U.S., World War I Draft Registration Cards, 1917-1918




Figure 351: 1880 United States Federal Census





Figure 352: U.S. City Directories, 1821-1899







Figure 357: Jacob Richard Death-2





Figure 366: 1850 United States Federal Census





Figure 367: Württemberg, Germany, Lutheran Baptisms, Marriages, and Burials, 1500-1985




Figure 368: Württemberg, Germany, Lutheran Baptisms, Marriages, and Burials, 1500-1985






Figure 375: Ohio, Wills and Probate Records, 1786-1998




Figure 376: U.S., Register of Civil, Military, and Naval Service, 1863-1959




Figure 377: U.S., Registers of Deaths of Volunteers, 1861-1865





Figure 378: Ohio, County Marriages, 1774-1993





Figure 380: 1830 United States Federal Census
